

Old Dominion Historical Fire Society (Parade Safety Advisory)

1. Insurance coverage on privately owned ODHFS member apparatus for parading is the responsibility of the individual apparatus Owner.
2. ODHFS parade participants are expected to fully abide by the established rules and regulations provided by the parade organizer.
3. Spotters should always be used when moving apparatus into line up areas or navigating through parade line up areas or exiting the parade route back into the flow of traffic.
4. Wheel chocking is mandatory in accordance with the ODHFS Safety Rules and Regulations.
5. Only ODHFS registered members will be able to participate in the parade if and when ODHFS is the registered participant. Non-member friends of ODHFS members will not be allowed to drive their vehicles or follow in behind ODHFS registered parade participants. Non-members of ODHFS must register for the parade individually in their own name
6. ODHFS parade participants will report to the ODHFS parade coordinator. (i. e. ODHFS Regional Director; ODHFS member who submitted the parade application, or ODHFS appointed Regional Safety Director) The parade coordinator shall be in attendance at the parade site.
7. The ODHFS parade coordinator will be responsible for adherence to ODHFS Safety Rules and Regulations of the ODHFS parade participants.
