Sledding Accident Scenario

Scenario: It late December and is a cold and bitter night with approximately 3" of snow on the ground. You know the younger brother was out sledding and comes in wet, crying, and without his jacket on. The younger brother is shivering uncontrollably and is irritable. The younger brother has minor cuts and scrapes to both hands. He is able to tell you that he was sledding and fell off the sled, hurting his hands. He can move his hands without any problems.

SAFETY	5 Max pts	
1. Scouts say they have medical gloves on or do have them on.	5	
CALLING FOR HELP	25 Max pts	
1. A Scout calls 911 or an adult for help	5	
2. The Scout tells what happened		
a. 9 year old male with hypothermia	5	
b. Minor cuts and scrapes on hands	5	
3. The Scout explains what is being done to the victim	5	
4. The scout gives the location	5	
TREAT FOR HYPOTHERMIA	25 Max pts	
1. Removes wet clothing	5	
2. Wraps victim in blankets, jackets, etc.	5	
3. Has victim drink warm liquids (soup, water, fruit juices)	5	
4. Uses warm water bottles or heat packs and places in the armpit and groin areas.	5	
5. Watches the person for change in condition	5	
TREAT CUTS AND SCRAPES	15 Max pts	
1. Wash hands with soap and water	5	
2. Apply anti-biotic ointment	5	
3. Cover with dry, sterile dressings or adhesive bandages	5
