You and Sandy Hook Vol. Fire & Rescue Company (SHVFR) agree that:

1. SHVFR members will be present at the 2019 Food Truck Frenzy in Sandy Hook on April 13, 2019. SHVFR will provide you with a space from which to sell your goods from your food truck. You will get all required permits and licenses, including, but not limited to, a mobile food license.
2. You will:
 - a) Submit this contract, along with a non-refundable participation fee, payable to *Sandy Hook Vol Fire* by March 15, 2019, and mail your payment to Sandy Hook Vol Fire — ATTN Food Truck Frenzy, PO Box 783, Sandy Hook CT 06482;
 - b) Follow our rules and instructions, including, but not limited to filing a Newtown Health District Temporary Food Service Form (SEE ATTACHED: "Food Truck Application Attachment"). PLEASE SEND ALL HEALTH DISTRICT PAPERWORK TO: Sandy Hook Vol Fire, along with a check for your \$25 Health Department Fee (Separate check from participation fee mentioned above in 2a);
 - c) Provide all food merchandise and sales staff necessary for your business;
 - d) Help SHVFR promote this event and your presence at this event by advertising your location through your social media sources;
 - e) Work from the space assigned to you by SHVFR, and be ready for business by the time specified on this contract; and
 - f) Obey all laws.
3. You will return your assigned space in the same condition as when you arrived. Any damage to the space — including but not limited to staining from the operation of the food cart or truck — will be fully remedied at your expense.
4. SHVFR does not control who enters the food truck area. Any security we provide is for our sole benefit. You take all risk of loss or damage to your merchandise or other property, regardless of cause. You must obtain any insurance you want for your merchandise and/or other property. If your property is lost, stolen or damaged, you will not look to the organizers for payment. Organizers mean us, our employees and agents and/or SHVFR. In addition, vendor is required to have liability insurance naming SHVFR as an additional insured. This should include products (in case of food poisoning) and auto insurance (in case vehicle hits a guest).
5. You agree to take part in the "2019 Food Truck Frenzy at Sandy Hook Vol. Fire" on the date of April 13, 2019. The participation fee is a donation, payable by March 15, 2019, by noon. If you cancel after this date, you are liable to Sandy Hook Vol. Fire for your donation. The event is rain or shine, no refunds will be given.
6. Any changes to this contract must be in writing and signed.

Weather Policy:

The Sandy Hook Vol Fire & Rescue Company 2019 Food Truck Frenzy is scheduled to take place Saturday, April 13, 2019. *The event will take place rain or shine.* Refunds will not be issued for inclement weather..

Fees:

Vendors participating in the 2019 Food Truck Frenzy at Sandy Hook Vol Fire & Rescue must have their participation fee (\$150) and The Health Department fee (\$25) paid in full by March 15, 2019, at noon. A check for The Health Department Fee should be a separate check/money order from your participation fee check/money order. *Incomplete applications or applications without proper payments will not be honored.*

Food Truck Vendor Fee:

\$150 to operate from 11 am-5 pm. You must close promptly at 5 pm on Saturday, April 13.

Health Inspections:

Prepared food vendors must provide Owner with a copy of their mobile food license. Vendors are expected to follow all rules and regulations as set forth by the Newtown Health District. All vendors must comply with all Newtown Health District Inspectors and their agents.

Promotions:

Vendors are encouraged to hold individual promotions as desired, which may include cross-promotion with other vendors.

Media Release:

By signing the Food Truck Vendor Contract and by participating in this event, you agree to the following statement:

"I hereby give my consent to all photographs, audio recordings, academic work and/or video recordings taken of me or my staff. I understand that any such photographs audio recording, academic work, and/or video recordings become the property of Owner and may be used by Owner, or others with their consent, for educational, instructional, or promotional purposes determined by Owner in broadcast and media formats now existing or created in the future."

Trash:

Trash receptacles will be placed throughout the area for customer use. Owner will not provide individual trash receptacles for individual vendors. Vendors are expected to take their individual business's trash with them at the end of the night or to dispose of trash in the large dumpsters provided in the parking lot. Vendors is not to use communal trash receptacles for their trash removal. Failure by Vendor to remove their trash can result in a fine of \$200.

Indemnification:

Vendors agrees to indemnify, defend, and forever save and hold harmless Sandy Hook Vol Fire Rescue Company, its members or any organization working with them, and any of its employees or agents, its affiliates or related entities, and their respective staff, shareholders, members, partners, officers, directors, employees, representatives, tenants, agents, contractors and volunteers, from and against any and all damages, claims, losses, demands, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees and costs), obligations, liens, liabilities, actions and causes of action, threatened or actual, which any one of the indemnities may suffer or incur arising from your acts or the breach of any agreement, obligation, warranty or representation made herein, or for claims not closely related to our duties under this Agreement, except to the extent such claims arise from our negligence or willful misconduct. The foregoing indemnification shall survive any termination or the expiration of the term of this agreement. Your indemnification does not extend to damages, claims, or losses occasioned by the acts of subcontractors of either your or our agents.
