

Old Dominion Historical Fire Society **(Regional Safety Officer Qualifications and Responsibilities)**

1. Safety background preferred for all candidates.
2. Candidate qualifications and information will be transmitted to the ODHFS Safety Director for consideration. Qualified Candidate names will be forwarded to the ODHFS Officers and Directors for Approval.
3. Able to complete all necessary safety reports, documentation and provide ODHFS Regional Safety Reports to the ODHFS Safety Director well in advance of the ODHFS Annual Meeting.
4. Must be dedicated to the position, and familiar with all ODHFS Safety Rules, Regulations, Policies and updates required.
5. Oversight of events, and assist at other ODHFS events outside their region.
6. Possess the ability to be able to effectively communicate and enforce ODHFS Safety Policies at events retaining a positive professional attitude when dealing with safety situations with ODHFS members and the general public.
7. Immediately report to the ODHFS Safety Director in writing any incidents or “near” misses.
8. The ability to provide input and make suggestions of ways to maintain effective ODHFS Safety Policies.
9. Possess the ability to work closely with respective ODHFS Regional Director.
