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Recruits attending this academy will need to provide their own PPE and learning materials to include the following:

- PPE to include: Structural Helmet, Eye Protection, 2 flash hoods, Bunker Jacket, Bunker pants, suspenders, two sets of structural gloves, bunker boots, hose strap, flash light that can be attached to bunker jacket, and personal spanner wrench. (All PPE must meet the NFPA standard for PPE and must be less than 10 years old). *Non – Sponsored Recruits will need to rent their PPE from a rental company.*
- SCBA Pack, 2 SCBA bottles, SCBA Mask. (All SCBA bottles must be with hydro test date and if sponsored shall provide copy of passing FIT test). *Non – Sponsored Recruits will need to rent their SCBA from a rental company. A FIT test will be provided by the academy for non-sponsored members.*
- Uniform items to include: Academy T-Shirt (provided by the academy), Basket Weave duty belt, Dark blue nomex pants (Workrite), Duty boots (Steel toe and shank). *Non – Sponsored Recruits will need to purchase their own uniform items.*
- PT Clothes to include: Shorts, Tennis Shoes.
- Learning Materials: IFSTA 7th Edition Essentials of Firefighting, IFSTA 4th Edition Hazardous Materials for First Responders, writing utensils, note pad and binder for notes. *Non – Sponsored Recruits will need to purchase their learning materials.*

There are multiple PPE and SCBA rental companies in the area, as long as the PPE and SCBA meet the NFPA standard then it will be acceptable to use. For uniform items you can use a local dealer or online such as thefirestore.com and for your learning materials you can use any source to purchase your books. *Sponsored recruits will need to work with their sponsoring agency on the above requirements.*
