

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 2004-4-13-1
ESTABLISHING FINES FOR FIRE CODE/ LIFE SAFETY VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS; The Supervisors of Hazle Township are concerned for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens who work in Hazle Township, and,

WHEREAS; It is the wish of the Supervisors of Hazle Township to help maintain as safe a working environment as is possible.


NOW THEREFORE; it is ordained at a duly advertised meeting of the Hazle Township Board of Supervisors that:


Upon inspection by the Hazle Township Fire Chief or Hazle Township Fire Inspector or their designee:

- 1. All violations of the Fire Code and/or Life Safety Violations shall be corrected within the time specified by the inspector; and
- 2. Life Safety violations shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$200.00 (per violation found) for the first offense and \$100.00 per day (per violation found) for each day each violation is not corrected in the time specified by the Inspector.
- 3. Repeat Fire Code Violations shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$50.00 for each repeat offense and \$100.00 per day for each day each violation is not corrected in the time specified by the Inspector.
- 4. Each day shall be considered a separate violation and all fines shall be accrued per day. Hazle Township may also file Civil or Criminal Charges with the District Justice with all costs being charged to the property owner.


