Hazle Twp. Ordinance # 2 – 1994
March 14, 1994

Permit Fees for fire prevention permits yearly fee.

1. Bowling Lanes; Refinishing and resurfacing of bowling lanes and pin refinishing.
Fee: \$20.00 per job.
2. Cellulose Nitrate Film; storage, handling, or use of cellulose nitrate film.
Fee: \$20.00 per year per project.
3. Combustible Fiber; storage, handling, or use of fiber covered by chapter 39 of this code.
Fee: \$20.00 per year per combustible fiber.
4. Compressed Gases; storage, handling, or use of compressed gasses. Installation, modification of any compressed gas system.
Fee: \$10.00 per gas for storage and handling per year.
Fee: \$10.00 per year for use per gas.
Fee: \$100.00 per installation or modification.
5. Dust explosion prevention; installation. modification of the following:
 - a. Grain bleacher or elevator.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
 - b. Starch, flour, or feed mill.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
 - c. Malt house.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
 - d. Wood flour manufacturing plant.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
 - e. Aluminum, cocoa, coal, magnesium, spices, sugar, or other facility that pulverizes materials subject to dust explosion.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
6. Any equipment that produces significant amounts of dust subject to an explosion.
Fee: \$20.00 per year
7. Flammable and combustible liquids:
 - a. Storage, use, handling, or transportation of class I, class II, or class IIIA flammable or combustible liquids.
Fee: \$25.00 pre year per operation
 - b. Manufacture, processing, blending, or refining.
Fee: \$25.00 per year per combustible liquid

8. Storage of oxidizers and organic peroxides regulated by chapter 27.
 - a. Materials classified as having more than one hazard category if the quantity limits are exceeded in any category.
Fee: \$100.00 per chemical
 - b. Repair, abandon, remove, place temporarily out-of-service, close, or substantially modify a storage facility.
Fee: \$100.00 per storage facility per year
 - c. Instillation, modification, alteration, or addition to any stationary aboveground or underground hazardous materials storage tank, secondary containment system, ventilation system, exhaust treatment system, explosion venting or suppression system, or gas detection system.
Fee: \$100.00 per system per year
 - d. A plan to close a facility or terminate storage, dispensing, handling, or use of hazardous materials shall be submitted for approval at least 30 days prior to the action. The plan shall demonstrate that hazardous materials that were stored, dispensed, handled, or used in the facility have been transported, disposed of, or reused in a manner that eliminates the need for further maintenance and any threat to public health and safety.
Fee: \$100.00 per plan per year
 - e. Storage, handling, or use of chlorine.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
 - f. Instillation or modification to any chlorine gas system
Fee: \$100.00 per instillation or modification.
9. Industrial ovens; operation of industrial ovens covered by chapter 36.
Fee: \$100.00 per oven per year
10. Lumber yards and woodworking plants; storage of lumber boards exceeding 100 feet.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
11. Magnesium; storage, handling, or processing of magnesium in quantities deemed significant by the authority having jurisdiction.
Fee: \$100.00 per processing per year
12. Organic coatings; operation and maintenance of a facility that manufactures organic coatings.
Fee: \$100.00 per year
13. Outdoor storages of scrap tires; establish, conduct, or maintain any outdoor storage of scrap tires that exceeds 2,500 cubic feet of total volume of scrap tires.
Fee: \$500.00 per storage per year.
14. Pyroxylin plastics; storage, handling, assembly, or manufacture of Pyroxylin plastics.
Fee: \$100.00 per process per year

15. Repair garages and service stations; operation of repair garages and service stations.
Fee: \$50.00 per garage and service station per year.

16. Tire rebuilding plants; operation and maintenance of a tire rebuilding plant.
Fee: \$100.00 per operation per year
Fee: \$10.00 per maintenance

Heavy Industrial Greater than 200,000 sq ft.....	\$ 200.00
