Treasurer's report:

Communications:

- Dry hydrant maps have been created and distributed electronically.
- 800 mhz radios have been installed in 19-2 and 31-1. Stations 16 and 13 will be installed soon. This allows these units to contact hospitals during transports across the bay.
- Updated map books (on CD) were distributed.
- Still having issues not being able to hear the "hospital side" of radio communications. Still working with Riverside and the contractor to resolve.
- Did not apply for an RSAF grant for AVL (automated vehicle locator) project. Currently working on a CAD project that will push incident data to units via a tablet/computer.
- Reminder that an additional company will be added to any grass/brush/field fire on any "class 3 or 4" days (designated by the forestry department) due to increased fire danger.
- 911 center has been the subject of Social Media criticism. Jeff asked that potential issues be brought directly to him instead of voicing concerns via Social Media outlets.
- The Bi-County Dispatch Committee will meet on 4/18 to discuss various dispatch topics.
