### Dear Neighbor:

We are writing to tell you about your local fire company the Penn Forest Volunteer Fire Company No. 2, located right across from Indian Mountain Lake development at 1507 Route 534. Our volunteer firefighters are the first responders for you local communities. We primarily serve Toamensing Trails, Valley View Estates, Mount Pocahontas, Jonas Mountain Estates, Hickory Run Estates, Stone Ridge Estates and Indian Mountain Lakes (Carbon). We also provide mutual aid to areas of Kinder Township, Jim Thorpe Borough, Monroe County and many more. In addition to fires, we respond to motor vehicle accidents, medical emergencies, aero medical landings, search and rescues, water rescues, and we are also an emergency shelter. Our first responders proudly dedicate themselves to serving the community, but we rely on the support of each and every one of you to provide the best service we can! Your support does not go unnoticed! Thanks to the generous donations and financial support from our township in the past, we were able to complete a three-bay addition to our firehouse. This past year we have expanded our recent building addition with a new pavilion for members to enjoy during the spring, summer, and autumn months. With the new pavilion, we were able to improve upon our community functions such as chicken barbecues and block shoots. Our members, and residents within the community, can enjoy a nice afternoon outside playing games, eating, and drinking with their local volunteers. The new pavilion has also increased the available space for private party rentals, making it the perfect spot to enjoy an outdoor party of any kind including birthdays, retirements, anniversaries, bridal and baby showers. Our officers and truck committee are also working hard on the acquisition of a new tanker truck to replace our current 1996 SEMO tanker. Our current tanker holds approximately 3500 gallons of water. Without access to hydrants in rural areas, a reliable and equipped tanker truck provides the main source of water on fire scenes, making this apparatus an invaluable piece of equipment to our first responders.

Although many fire companies struggle with manpower, our community continues to come together and our firefighter family continues to grow! However, with all growth, we encounter additional expenses for gear, equipment, tools, and training. Each firefighter is required to complete a minimum of 160 hours of training. This helps us ensure that our responders are competently trained in their skills and knowledge and can safely respond to all emergency dispatches they may encounter. As members/residents, you may already be aware of our successful social club fundraiser for the fire department. The Firehouse Grill is located within the firehouse building and holds many community events throughout the year. These events include, but are not limited to, live entertainment and shows, Friday night dinners for the whole family, holiday activities with children, and various bar leagues and games throughout the week and available to the whole community.
