**Purpose**

To set forth a standardized guideline related to the various awards given to members at the annual banquet.

**Guideline**

**Firefighter of the Year**

- Must be an active member in good standing for the entire year.
- Must be moving forward with their firefighting skills.
- Attends Alarms, Drills, and Meetings regularly.
- Must have completed FF1 or Fire Scene Support Ops.
- Shows a willingness to help other firefighters when needed.
- Must show a positive attitude towards the SVFD and its membership.
  - Member will receive a take home award as well as a choice of the following: leather New Yorker helmet or a set of leather boots.

**Rookie of the Year**

- Must be an active member in good standing with less than 20 months in the department.
- Must be moving forward in their firefighting skills.
- Attends Alarms, Drills, and Meetings regularly.
- Shows a willingness to learn new skills.
  - Member will receive a take home award and a jacket with department logo.

**Alarm Responses**

- A certificate and gift will be given for all members over 100 alarms
  - (Awards will be determined by the Chiefs office prior to the banquet)

**Training Awards**

- The member with the highest number of training hours for the year includes department training, State and County Training including EMS.
  - Member will receive Department Work Shirt (sweatshirt style)

**Top Responder**

- This award will be given to the member who responds to the most alarm
  - Member will receive a Leatherman style Multi tool
