Purpose:

To establish a standard criteria for members of the Scriba Volunteer Fire Department related to promotion to a Line Officer position.

Guideline:

In order for a member to be considered for promotion they must have shown active participation in the departments alarms, training activities, and fundraising as well as promoting a safe and positive attitude.

All Fire Line Officers shall be appointed by the elected Chief of the Department and must have completed the following requirements:

LIEUTENANT

Minimum of two years active firefighting service in this department
 NYS Firefighter I or equivalent
 NYS Firefighter II or equivalent
 Department SCBA Qualified
 Firefighter Survival
 EVOC + Pump Operator course
 IS 100, IS 200, IS 700
 CPR minimum or EMS Certification

CAPTAIN

Minimum of three years active firefighting service in this department
 One year as Lieutenant or Higher
 All courses required for Lieutenant
 Fire Officer 1
 Firefighter assist and safety team (FAST)

SAFETY OFFICER

Minimum of ten years firefighting service
 All courses required for a Captain
 Shows a knowledge of safe fire operations
 Building Construction- Combustible
 Building construction- non- combustible
 Light weight construction

or

Has held a Chief Officer Position in this Department

As previously stated Line Officers are appointed and can be removed from Their position by the Chief at anytime if the member is not meeting the obligation or responsibilities given him/her.
