## NORTH VALLEY DISTRICT 2008 FIRST AID MEET

### Burn & Laceration Scenario

Scenario: While making dinner at Camp Star's First Class Campsite, a scout spills boiling water on his left forearm and screams. A nearby scout cutting onions looks up and cuts his left index finger with a knife.

The first scout's left forearm is red and is beginning to blister. The second scout's left index finger is a minor laceration and he feels sick and faint.

Though the patrol has a cell phone available, there is no reception. The closest help is at the camp's health lodge, approximately 7 minutes away.

Only the patrol leader and the Scouts that go for help may speak to the judge.

ACTION TAKEN	POSSIBLE POINTS	POINTS EARNED
<b>GOING FOR HELP</b>	<b>5 Max pts</b>	
1. Patrol sends two Scouts to get help	5	
<b>CALLING FOR HELP</b>	<b>40 Max pts</b>	
1. The Scout tells what happened		
a. A scout has a 2 <sup>nd</sup> degree (partial thickness) burn on his left forearm from boiling water.	5	
b. A 2 <sup>nd</sup> scout has cut his left index finger and it is bleeding.	5	
c. The 2 <sup>nd</sup> scout feels sick and faint	5	
3. The Scout gives location as the First Class Campsite	5	
4. The Scout explains what is being done		
a. The burn was cooled with cool water and bandaged	5	
b. The laceration was cleaned and bandaged	5	
c. The 2 <sup>nd</sup> scout is being treated for shock	5	
5. The Scout escorts the Health Officer to the campsite	5	
<b>BURN TREATMENT PROCEDURE</b>	<b>30 Max pts</b>	
1. The patient's burn is cooled with cold, running water until the pain is relieved.	10	
2. When the burn area is dry, apply loosely a sterile gauze pad and bandage.	20	
3. <i>If butter, creams, ointments, or sprays are applied –</i>	-5	

<i>subtract 5 points</i>		
<b>LACERATION TREATMENT PROCEDURE</b>	<b>20 Max pts</b>	
1. Clean with water, flushing for 5 minutes or until any foreign matter is removed.	5	
2. Apply triple antibiotic ointment (Neosporin) if no allergies or sensitivities to the medication.	10	
3. Covered with a dry, sterile dressing and bandage	5	
4. Covered with an adhesive bandage (band-aid)	3	
<i>NOTE: POINTS ONLY GIVEN FOR EITHER #3 or #4, NOT BOTH</i>		
<b>TREATMENT FOR SHOCK PROCEDURE-Burn Victim</b>	<b>10 Max pts</b>	
1. Had the patient sit with his head between his knees or had him lay down and raised his legs about 12 inches.	10	
<b>TREATMENT FOR SHOCK PROCEDURE-Laceration Victim</b>	<b>10 Max pts</b>	
2. Had the patient sit with his head between his knees or had him lay down and raised his legs about 12 inches.	10	
<b>SAFETY PRECAUTIONS</b>	<b>10 Max pts</b>	
1. Scout(s) treating burn used medical gloves	5	
2. Scout(s) treating laceration used medical gloves	5
