The race will start promptly at 2:00 P.M.

RULES

1. All cardboard crafts must be built solely of cardboard, tape, string, glue, and paper. Sleds may be colored and painted. Any other material in any part of the craft is grounds for disqualification.
2. Teams are to consist of one to four Crew members per craft.
3. Tape is permissible on the surface of the craft where it meets the snow.
4. A craft cannot be completely enclosed with a participant inside.
5. Anchors of any kind as well as other braking devices are unnecessary and prohibited.
6. Crew members must wear a helmet and appropriate clothing.
7. No buckling, tying or strapping into crafts.
8. All participants must sign a release form; less than 18 years of age require a parental consent. These will be available at registration. Crews from other Districts are welcome.
9. Teams must register prior to the event. There will be a mandatory captains meeting before the start of the race.
10. Sleds are to check in at designated sled pit area for sled inspection at 12-1:00 P.M. All sleds must be present in the pit area no later than 1:00 P.M. for Judging.
11. Each team is responsible for clearing the mountain of their craft as well as any debris from the craft after their run and taking their craft home with them. Be Scouts and Leave No Trace!
12. Each team will get one run down the course. Should a sled fall over or rollover it must clear the runway as soon as it comes to a stop. If the craft comes to a stop and cannot make it all the way down under its own momentum the craft must clear the runway.
13. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Judges. The decision of the event committee concerning awards or disqualification is final.
14. All teams must adhere strictly to the rules or they will not be allowed to race.
15. Unsportsmanlike conduct is grounds for disqualification.
