NORTH VALLEY DISTRICT 2018 FIRST AID MEET Bleeding Scenario

Scenario: Your scout patrol is doing a midnight hike while there is a full moon out. While hiking on the American Trail about 2 miles from the town of New London, the patrol hears screaming and growling noises coming from a group that was in front of them hiking. The patrol arrives on scene and finds three members of the group crying and yelling for help, while a fourth member, a male, is laying on the ground with uncontrollable bleeding from a 6 inch gash on his lower left leg beginning at his knee. The male has a 2 inch laceration on his right arm above his wrist which is bleeding slowly. The male is conscious and tells you his name is Lon Chaney and he is 24 years old. The male states that an unknown animal attacked him while he was hiking. No one in either group has a cell phone, however; there is a restaurant called Silver Bullet about ½ mile away that is open.

APPROACHING THE SCENE	10 Max pts	
1. Scouts ask if the scene is safe	5	
2. Scouts say they have medical gloves on or do have them on	5	
TOURNIQUET APPLICATION	30 Max pts	
1. SCOUTS APPLY TOURNIQUET IMMEDIATELY	15	
2. Tourniquet is applied above the wound on the left leg	5	
3. Tourniquet is secured after being made tight	5	
4. Patrol documents time the Tourniquet is applied	5	
GASH WOUND TREATMENT PROCEDURE	15 Max pts	
1. Clean the wound with water (no loss of points if soap used)	5	
2. Apply gauze and bandage	10	
TREATMENT OF RIGHT ARM LACERATION	10 Max pts	
1. Wash with soap and water	5	
2. Apply gauze and bandage	5	
TREATMENT FOR SHOCK	15 Max pts	
1. Keep the victim warm by covering with a blanket.	5	
2. Elevate legs to control bleeding and treat for shock	10

GOING FOR HELP	5 Max pts	
1. Patrol sends two Scouts to call for help <i><u>(if only 1 scout goes, then 2 points)</u></i>	5	
CALLING FOR HELP	30 Max pts	
1. The Scout tells what happened		
a. 24 year old male (Deduct 1 point if no age is given) (Deduct 1 point if male is not stated) (Deduct 1 point if no name is given)	5	
b. Male has a gash on left leg	5	
c. Tourniquet was applied	5	
d. Male is conscious	5	
2. The Scout explains what is being done to the victim	5	
3. The scout gives the location as being at ½ mile from Silver Bullet restaurant or offers to take them to the scene.	5
