## NORTH VALLEY DISTRICT 2018 FIRST AID MEET Monkey Bridge Accident Scenario

Scenario: It's close to midnight and your patrol is doing a scavenger hunt at scout camp. Your patrol hears a scream from up a head. Upon investigating, your patrol finds a 40 year old leader, Boris Karloff, laying on his back. He fell 10 feet from the monkey bridge that scouts had built earlier at Scoutcraft. Mr. Karloff is complaining of left leg pain and head pain. Your patrol observes a deformed lower left leg (indicating a break) and a 2" laceration above the right elbow that is slowly bleeding. There are obvious signs that Mr. Karloff hit his head on the ground when he fell. Your patrol does not have any cell phones. The closest troop site is about 1/4 mile from Scoutcraft.

ACTION TAKEN	POSSIBLE POINTS	POINTS EARNED
<b>APPROACHING THE SCENE</b>	<b>15 Max pts</b>	
1. Scouts ask if the scene is safe	5	
2. Scout (a) tells the victim who they are and (b) asks if the victim wants help <i><b>(2 points if they do just 1)</b></i>	5	
3. Scouts say they have medical gloves on or do have them on.	5	
<b>STABILIZE VICTIM</b>	<b>20 Max pts</b>	
1. Patrol stabilizes the head by holding the head in the position found and not allowing the patient to move it.	20	
<b>LACERATION TREATMENT PROCEDURE</b>	<b>20 Max pts</b>	
1. Wash/clean the wound with soap and water or just flush with water.	5	
2. With a clean cloth or dressing apply direct pressure.	10	
3. Bandage the wound using gauze wrap or triangular bandage.	5	
<b>TREATMENT FOR BROKEN LEG</b>	<b>35 Max pts</b>	
1. Splint in position found.	5	
2. Splints reach from the middle of the thigh to past the heel.	5	
3. One splint on each side of the left leg.	5	
4. Splints firmly secured using gauze rolls or triangular bandages.	5	
5. Padding used to fill in voids, if necessary	5	
6. Pulse or capillary refill is checked after splinting.	5	
7. Person is asked to wiggle the toes or asked if they can feel the person touching their toes.	5	
<b>TREATMENT FOR SHOCK</b>	<b>5 Max pts</b>	
1. Keep the victim warm by covering with a blanket.	5	
<b>OTHER</b>	<b>5 Max pts</b>	
1. Patrol does not move patient at all, including legs, etc.	5

**Monkey Bridge Accident Scenario:  
 CALLING FOR HELP**

<b>GOING FOR HELP</b>	<b>5 Max pts</b>	
1. Patrol sends two Scouts to call for help <i><u>(if only 1 scout goes, then 2 points)</u></i>	5	
<b>CALLING FOR HELP</b>	<b>25 Max pts</b>	
1. The Scout tells what happened		
a. 40 year old male fell from monkey bridge (Deduct 1 point if no age is given) (Deduct 1 point if male is not stated) (Deduct 1 point if no name is given)	5	
b. Male has a laceration above right elbow/upper right arm	5	
c. Male has a broken lower left leg (Deduct 1 point if left is not stated)	5	
2. The Scout explains what is being done to the victim	5	
3. The scout gives the location as being at Scoutcraft	5
