Saturday, Sept. 17th from 8 a.m. until noon

LOCATION: The start/finish line will be at the Nuremberg-Weston Volunteer Fire Company, 459 Hazle Street, Weston, PA 18256. Race Director: Doug Demshock, (570)751-3162 or ddemshock@gmail.com.

DETAILS: Registration is from 7-7:45 am on race day. Run/walk starts at 8 am. There will be a children's 1 mile fun run immediately following the run/walk. Race will be timed and scored by Second Wind Timing. Event will be held rain or shine. No refunds. All participants who are pre-registered by August 5, 2022 are guaranteed to receive a t-shirt. All others will receive a t-shirt on a first come first serve basis. Shirts will be distributed the day of the event. Leashed pets are welcome to participate. We ask that everyone observe social distancing requirements.

COURSE: Primarily a road course with gentle hills and flat areas. Route travels through the towns of Nuremberg and Weston.

AWARDS: Separate awards for the first male and female runner to cross the finish line. Plus, 3 male & female winners for the following age groups: 12 & under, 13-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 and up. Also, awards for the top 3 male & female Emergency Responders. There will be an awards ceremony following the kid's 1 mile fun run.
