ICE / Cold Water Rescue –Technician Level

Date:	March 9 & 10 (Saturday & Sunday)
Time:	8:00am – 5:00pm
<u>Location:</u>	Webster Fire Department 35 South Ave, Webster 14580
<u>Prerequisites:</u>	Rescue Technician Basic (preferred, not required)
<u>Materials Needed:</u>	Ice/Cold Water Suit (NOT provided), Warm clothing
<u>Course Information:</u>	This course provides an advanced level ice rescue training including self-rescue, shore based ice rescue techniques, and go ice rescue techniques. This is a hands-on training program which includes a significant amount of on ice time for skill practice. It also addresses the effects of cold water on victims, ice rescue techniques, off shore techniques, and ice rescue equipment. Course will include several scenario based ice rescue exercises. This class is lecture and field based. Students will be in cold water for ¾ of the course and should plan accordingly.

Student enrollment is limited to 20.

Pre-registration is required and no one will be admitted without pre-registration. Pre-registration can be accomplished by completing the enclosed form (Fire Bureau Student Registration Form) and returning it to the Fire Bureau (hand deliver, email or FAX to 753-3867). **The deadline for registration is March 1, 2019 at NOON.**
