<u>Course Information:</u>	Introduces special characteristics of noncombustible and fire resistive construction as they concern the fire service. Primary emphasis is on improving the fire officer's ability to ensure firefighter safety by recognizing common causes and indicators of failure and other hazards related to building construction. Course material enables the fire officer to better predict the overall reaction of a building to fire conditions.

Student enrollment is limited to 30.

Pre-registration is **required** and no one will be admitted without pre-registration.
